

# **General Terms and Conditions**

## Definition

5G Lab GmbH is the conference organizer of the Dresden Chips & Communications Festival 2025, which takes place from May 12 – 16, 2025 at Messe Dresden, Germany. It includes the two main events IEEE 6G Summit Dresden and IEEE Chips Summit, which run from May 14-15. In addition, several side events such as the 6G life General Assembly and the Chipdesign Germany Forum 2025, will be organized within the DCCF from May 12-16. The General Terms and Conditions apply to all registered participants of the main events and all side events.

## 1. Registration and payments

The registration is solely possible online via Eventbrite. Eventbrite will send a registration confirmation and an invoice (if applicable) via email. All registration fees must be paid in due time according to the due date stated on the invoice. An additional cost of 50€ excluding tax is charged in case of late payments that are not received 14 days prior to the start of the event. Participation will be refused if not all participant's payments are received prior to the start of the event.

**The Registration deadline is April 15, 2025, 23:30:00 CET.** For registrations after April 15, 2025, 23:30:00 CET **a late fee of 50€** excl. tax applies. For Last Minute Tickets after May 6, 2025, 23:30:00 CET an additional **last-minute fee of 50€** excl. tax applies.

Payment can be made by credit card, debit card, PayPal, or Sofort-Überweisung. Cash or cheques will not be accepted. Any bank charges must be paid by the participant.

## 2. Changing the participant's registration

Registrations cancelled before **April 15, 2025, 23:30:00 CET** are fully refundable. Registrations cancelled before May 6, 2025, 23:30:00 CET are eligible for a 50% refund of the registration fees paid. Registrations cancelled after May 6, 2025, 23:30:00 CET are not eligible for a refund. Open payments will be waived accordingly. Substitution/transferring of registration or attendance ticket is not permitted, and no refund will be given for unattendance or early termination of attendance. Attempts to transfer or forward a registration/participation will invalidate the right to gain entrance (online and onsite) to the conference.

All registration changes and cancellations must be communicated to 5G Lab GmbH by email to <u>events@5glab.de</u> or through Eventbrite.



## 3. Travel arrangements

Travel arrangements (including visa) and accommodation are the responsibility of the participants. Registered participants can request an official Letter of Invitation (for e.g. visa application) via <u>events@5glab.de</u>

## 4. Cancellation or rescheduling of conference

In case of events beyond the control of the conference organizers ("force majeure") hampering the conference to take place as planned, the organizer nor the host can be held liable for any participant's damage or loss. Under these circumstances, the organizer reserves the right to reschedule the conference and the registrations.

#### 5. Film, Photo, Video and Audio Recordings

Participants are not permitted to audio or videorecord sessions without the express written permission of the conference organizer. The conference organization team will take photographs, video and audio recordings of this presentations and the participants. The captured images, photographs, audio, or likeness can be used of business and promotional purposes on conference-related websites or printed matters. #### 6. Data privacy

- Improving user experience on our website.
- Authenticating, securing and collecting statistics on remote connections.



The data retention period is minimized and data that are not useful anymore are deleted. The data retention period is determined by considering the legal, security, management, and other legitimate service requirements. Personal data are processed with care and strict rules are applied to avoid any unnecessary data transfers to third parties or to geographic locations that may expose the data at risk. The conference organizer and host use physical, technical, and administrative measures to safeguard information in our possession against loss, theft and unauthorized use, disclosure, or modification. Please note, however, that no data transmission or storage can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. As a result, while striving to protect the information we maintain, we cannot ensure or warrant the security of any information that you transmit to us.

## 7. Insurance and liability

The registration does not include insurance of any kind. The conference organizer and host have no responsibility nor liability for damage, loss or injury that may arise from participation or attending the conference. Each participant acts at its own risk and must adhere to all safety and health instructions and protocols put in place by the host/organizer during the conference.

The court of jurisdiction is Dresden. The German law applies. All dates and times mentioned in line with the registration refer to Central European Time (CET).

## 8. Severability Clause

If there is a determination of these Terms and Conditions to be ineffective or impracticable, then the validity of the Terms and Conditions remaining are not impaired. The parties are obligated to cooperate to replace the ineffective or impracticable clause by an effective or feasible clause, which results in the ineffective or impracticable clause being closed.
